Title: “A Well Ordered Body, Pt. 2” by Rev. John Downs

Text: 1 Corinthians 14:26-40

A well ordered body worship in submission to the direction of God.

I. Submission to the direction of God in principle v. 26-33a

II. Submission to the particular direction of God v. 33b-40

Application – “But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves” (James 1:22).

Our responsibility, by God’s grace and power, is to consistently apply the truths of God’s Word that we have heard to our lives (Phil. 2:1-13; 1 Tim. 4:7-9; James 1:22-27). As you meditate on the sermon and this passage of Scripture, ask yourself these questions:

- Is there a command to obey?
- Is there an example to follow?
- Is there a promise to claim?
- Is there a sin to avoid?
- Is there a principle to follow?
