Title: “A Glorious Body Glorified” by Rev. John Downs

Text: 1 Corinthians 15:35-49

The gospel brings us from one degree of glory to the next

I. The first degree of glory v. 35-41

II. The final degree of glory v. 42-49

Application – “But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves” (James 1:22).

Our responsibility, by God’s grace and power, is to consistently apply the truths of God’s Word that we have heard to our lives (Phil. 2:1-13; 1 Tim. 4:7-9; James 1:22-27). As you meditate on the sermon and this passage of Scripture, ask yourself these questions:
