Title: “Partakers of Redemption” by Rev. John Downs

Text: Titus 3:3-7

Q. 29. How are we made partakers of the redemption purchased by Christ?

A. We are made partakers of the redemption purchased by Christ, by the effectual application of it to us by his Holy Spirit.

Our triune God accomplishes redemption and applies it to his people.

Application – “But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves” (James 1:22).
